To receive feedback from schools before the official launch of the CPB Handbook 2010.



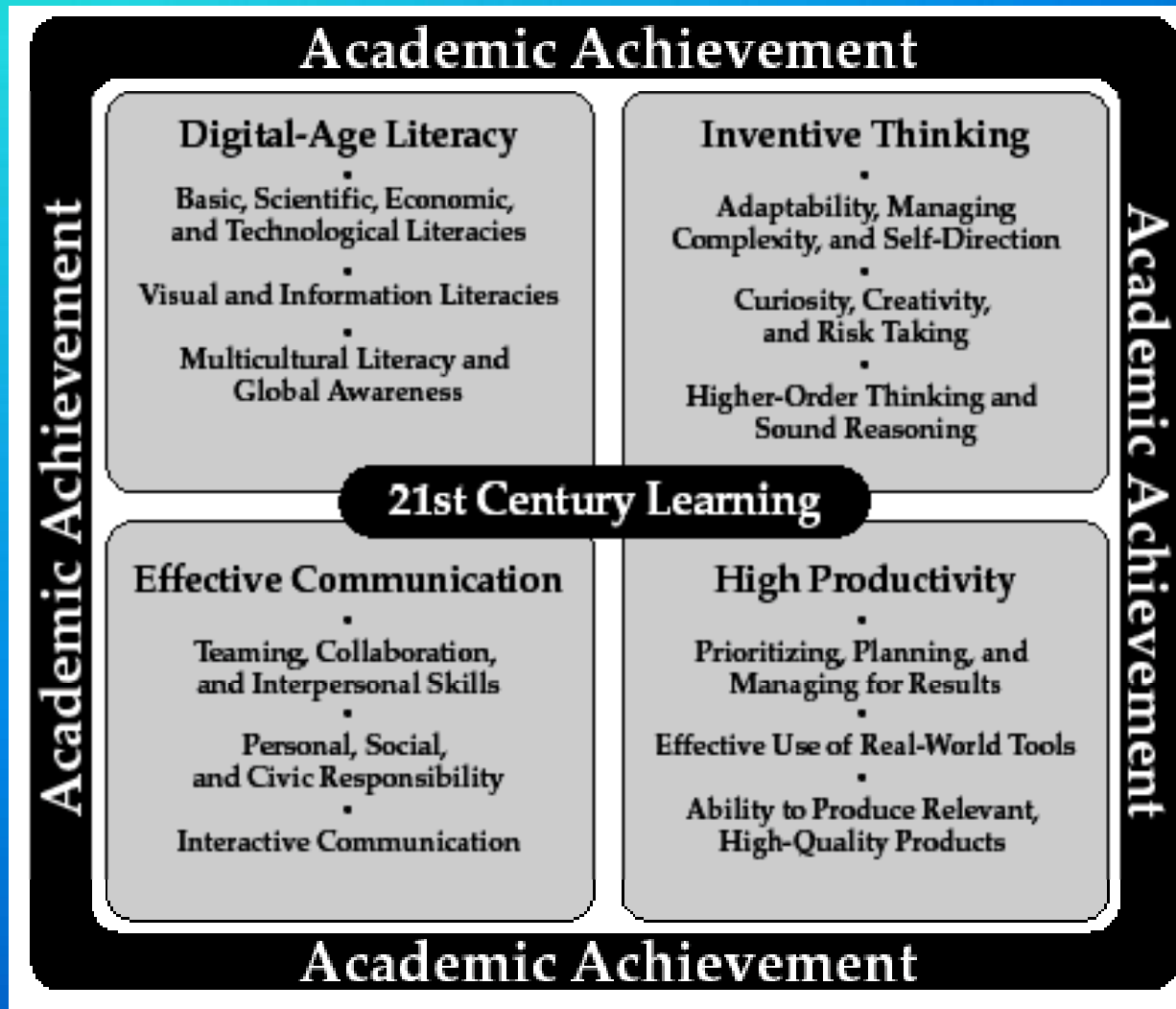

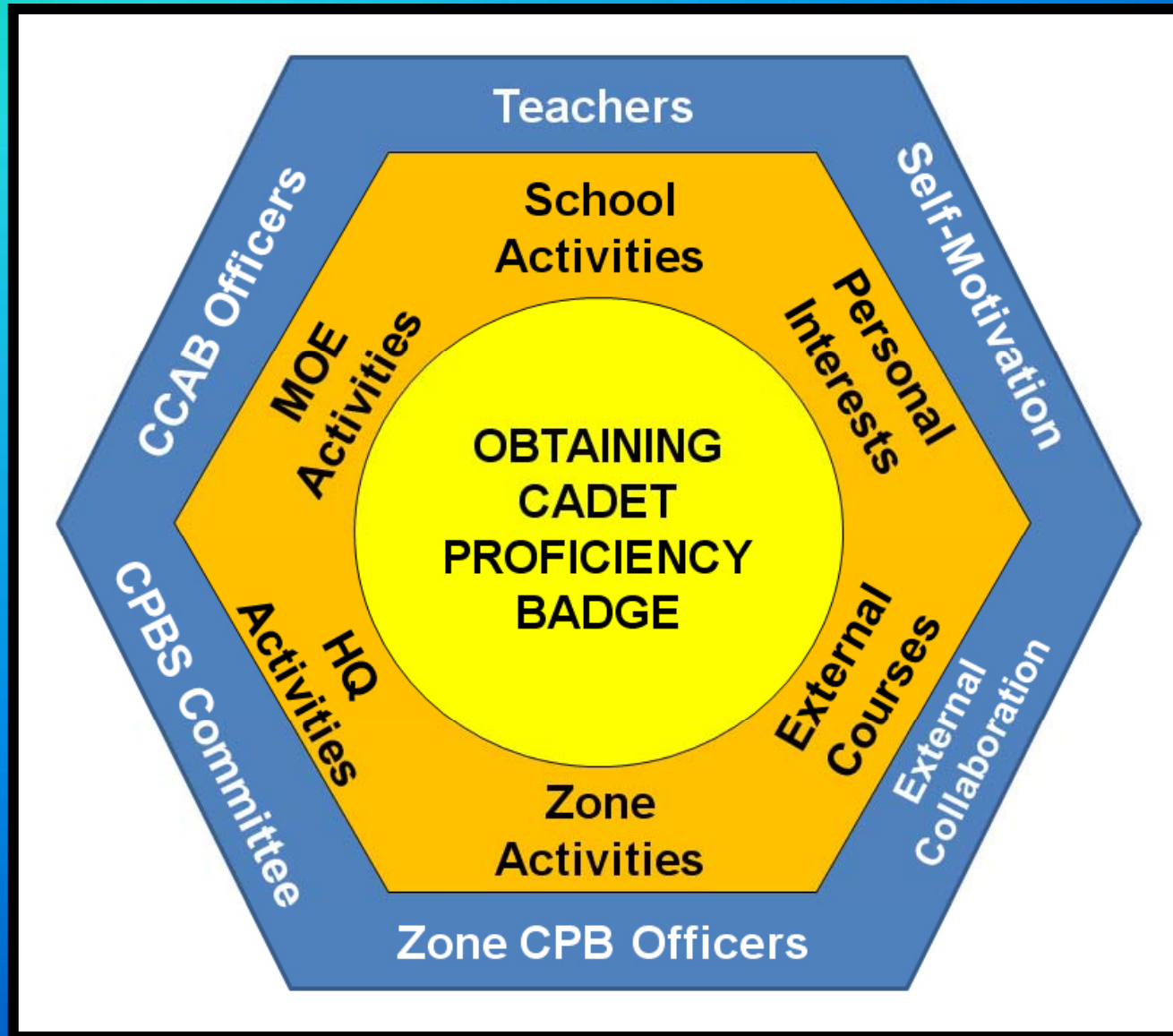

Rationale behind CPB Handbook 2010

To keep up with the educational landscape

Encourage cadets to develop holistic education

Promotes participation in CPB-related activities

- Not too easy to achieve badges
- Not be too difficult to achieve badges
- A purpose to carry out badge activities
- Encourages self-achievement



In a nutshell...

Changes in the CPB Curriculum

- Renaming badges
- Removing badges (not realistic to carry out)
- Merge badges (duplicate activities)
- Introduce additional criteria to achieve awards
 - making more challenging!!
- Introducing new / additional resources to existing badges
 - More opportunities to achieve the badge(s)

Sec 4 cadets who are qualified in 2010 (with or without TDF/110)	To award the cadets with CCB/001 accordingly

Sec 3 cadets who are qualified in 2010 (without TDF/110)	School to advise the cadet to complete TDF/110 before 1 st June 2010

What is affected?

Commissioner's Badge

Scenario from 1 st January to 31 st May 2010	Actions to be taken by HQ / School
Sec 4 cadets who were qualified in 2009 but KIV till 2010 (with or without Total Defence Silver)	To award the cadets with DCB/002 accordingly
Sec 3 cadets who were qualified in 2009 but KIV till 2010 (with TDF/110) – means with TD (Silver)	To qualify the cadets with DCB/002 accordingly
Sec 3 cadets who were qualified in 2009 but KIV till 2010 (without TDF/110)	School to advise the cadet to complete Total Defence Silver (thus obtain TDF/110) before 1 st June 2010
Cadets Sec 2 and below who were qualified in 2009 but KIV till 2010	Cadets will not qualify for this badge until they fulfill all requirements.
Sec 4 cadets who were qualified in 2010 (with or without TDF/110)	To award the cadets with DCB/002 accordingly
Sec 3 cadets who were qualified in 2010 (with TDF/110)	To qualify the cadets with DCB/002 accordingly
Sec 3 cadets who were qualified in 2010 (without TDF/110)	School to advise the cadet to complete Total Defence Silver (thus obtain TDF/110) before 1 st June 2010
Cadets Sec 2 and below who are qualified in 2010	Cadets will not qualify for this badge until they fulfill all requirements.

What is affected?

Total Defence Badge (TDF/110)

Cadets who have already achieved the TDF/110 badge need not have to complete Total Defence Gold in order to re-qualify for this badge.

Cadets who have yet to start Total Defence Silver badge will have to achieve Total Defence Gold in order to qualify for this badge.

All other badges

Schools are encouraged to adopt the new criteria during the soft launch period. This is to facilitate smooth transition once the launch takes place in June 2010.
