



## NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION PROFICIENCY BADGE SCHEME 2010

1. INTRODUCTION  
The National Crime Prevention Council (NCPC) conducts the National Crime Prevention Proficiency Badge Scheme on an annual basis. NCPC aims to collaborate with all UGs in an effort to maximise outreach to students in raising crime prevention awareness.
2. CATEGORIES  
The course will be conducted in two categories:
  - (a) Primary
  - (b) Secondary
3. REQUIREMENTS
  - (a) A basic knowledge of crime prevention
  - (b) Personal assignment (Log/Scrap book)
  - (c) Visit to Crime Prevention Exhibition Centre
  - (d) Written test
  - Participants must complete part (a), (b) and (c) before sitting-in for the written test. Details and requirements are stipulated in the handbooks.
4. ELIGIBILITY
  - (a) Only students registered with the Uniformed Groups are allowed to participate in the badge scheme.
5. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF LEADERS  
Leaders need to:
  - Supervise and assess all personal assignments and to sign all test cards.
  - Mark the answer scripts for the written test, collate and submit only the results of the assignments and the written test to the UG HQ.
6. VISITS TO THE CRIME PREVENTION EXHIBITION CENTRE
  - (a) Leaders must make appointments for visits with the Police Officer in-charge of the Centre.
  - (b) Leaders must comply strictly to the time slot allocated.
  - (c) Leaders must remind their students to bring along their own copy of Handbook for endorsement during the visit to the exhibition.
  - (d) Leaders must inform the Police Officer in-charge of the centre at least **three working days** in advance if they cannot go, based on a valid reason.
7. WRITTEN TEST
  - (a) Leaders must conduct the written test in their respective schools.
  - (b) Leaders are to mark the scripts immediately after the test.
  - (c) All tests must be conducted **by September 2010**.

8. BADGES AND CERTIFICATES

- (a) Badges and certificates will be awarded to students who passed the badge course.
- (b) UG HQ will inform the respective Leaders to collect their badges and certificates.

9. BADGE SCHEME SCHEDULE

Please adhere strictly to the dates as follows:

31 May 2010	Orientation Workshop for Leaders
22 – 26 Jun 2010	Collection of course materials for the participants at respective UG HQ
28 Jun – 30 Jul 2010	Visit to the Neighbourhood Police Centre
Aug 2010	Completion of the Course assignments by participants
Sep 2010	Written test to be conducted in school
4 Oct 2010	Submission of Course results to UG HQ. (Thereafter, UG HQ to submit returns to NCPC).
To be advised	Collection of badges and certificates.
