# Get Involved in Total Defence!

*Students to choose any 1 Option*

**Option 1:** Participating in the Community Safety and Security Programme Camp (CSSP Camp)

**Option 2:** Participating in the Total Defence ExploRally

**Option 3:** Participating in Community Service

**For Option 1 or 2:** Schools must submit documentary proof of the cadets' participation in the event from the organisers.

**For Option 3:** Schools must submit detailed information of cadets' involvement in the Community Service.



## Details of Option 3 (Community Service)

The number of hours clocked must fulfill **30 hours over a period of 6 months**

- according to Community Care CPB criteria).
- The detailed information can be shown in a form of a table.

## Details of Option 3 (Community Service)

For 2011, the following members are advised to use record the Community Service hours accordingly:

### Secondary 3, 4 and 5 members

- ✓ Use existing CIP hours recorded in School Cockpit as supporting documents.
- ✓ Highlight the activities that are relevant. They can use the record form to continue to clock the community service hours required.

### Secondary 1 and 2 members

- ✓ Start to use the suggested record forms accordingly.
- ✓ All signatures by the respective organisation must be completed before submission.



# Details of Option 3 (Community Service) cont'd...

## Suggested Community Service Activities

✓ - recognised, ✗ - not recognised

S/N	Activity	Activity Recognition
1	CIP Activity organised by school (outside school) ▪Activity is recorded in School Cockpit/Results Slip	✓
2.	CIP Activity organised by school (inside school) ▪Examples are class/school leaders, cleaning up school	✗
3.	CIP/Community Service Activity organised by Zone/HQ/Corps ( <b>NOT recorded</b> as public duty hours)	✓
4.	CIP/Community Service Activity organised by Zone/HQ/Corps (to be recorded as public duty hours)	✗
5.	All public duties performed in the name of SJAB, the school, or Ministry of Education and recorded as public duty hours	✗



# FAQs

1. Can the Community Service hours from different events to clock the 30 hours?

**Yes, as long as it fulfills 30 hours over a period of 6 months.**

2. Can I use this to clock Community Care Badge under CPB and part of Total Defence Gold submission.

**Yes. It does not 'violate' the use of an activity to earn two badges directly.**

3. Why is there a CIP requirements when syllabus doesn't indicate any?

**We agree that there is no indication in the Total Defence Gold Syllabus. But the syllabus also mentions that it must be up and above the usual hours done in the UG. Hence, SJAB HQ decides to set a standard across all schools.**



# FAQs

4. Can my cadets participate in Part 3 of the Total Defence Gold even before they start this course?

**Yes. The recommended level to start is when the cadet starts on the Silver badge lessons/activities.**

5. Why can't the public duty hours be used to clock the Community Service hours?

**Public duties are already recorded in the cadet's BF4/BF1.**

6. What happens if there are no CSSP and/or Explorally activities organised / I have missed these activities for Part 3?

**You will have to work on Community Service activities. You can tap onto past CIP activities and 'work backwards' towards the submission.**
